The camp is only deployed when in use, then completely packed down after guests depart—ensuring no permanent structures are left behind and the landscape is returned entirely to nature. This minimal-impact model supports Loisaba's conservation goals by preserving the integrity of the surrounding ecosystem and reducing human footprint.
